Mortgage Paydown Update



We are thrilled to announce that as of April 9th, we have raised over \$13,900 to pay our remaining mortgage balance. Treasurer Greg Turcotte has transferred the last payment of \$11,245.00 to First Seacoast Bank. We are officially mortgage free!!

The remaining balance of \$2,655 and any additional donations intended for the mortgage will go toward our Building Sustainability Campaign. Some of that money is already earmarked to repair the side access ramp. We will also be moving forward with the exterior painting the Dover side of the building and our kitchen porch with CertaPro. They did a phenomenal job last year with the Route 4 and Roberts Road sides!


Thank you to all of our many volunteers and donors, who keep our community theater alive and moving toward a vibrant future!


